AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money; ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold AHBA, Stoner Enterprises, this club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog, where such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury; be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

TEST AWARDS

Disaster and Emergency Plans for People and Dogs at this Herding Event

Fire: Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.

Thunderstorms and Lightning: Should lightning be observed, all personnel and animals should move or be moved to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.

Forest Fire: All people and their secured dogs should immediately follow fire/emergency personnel evacuation directions and orders.

Earthquake: Remain on the site with all dogs secured. Use arenas for emergency animal housing if necessary.

Mass Disaster Plan – Tornado: In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.

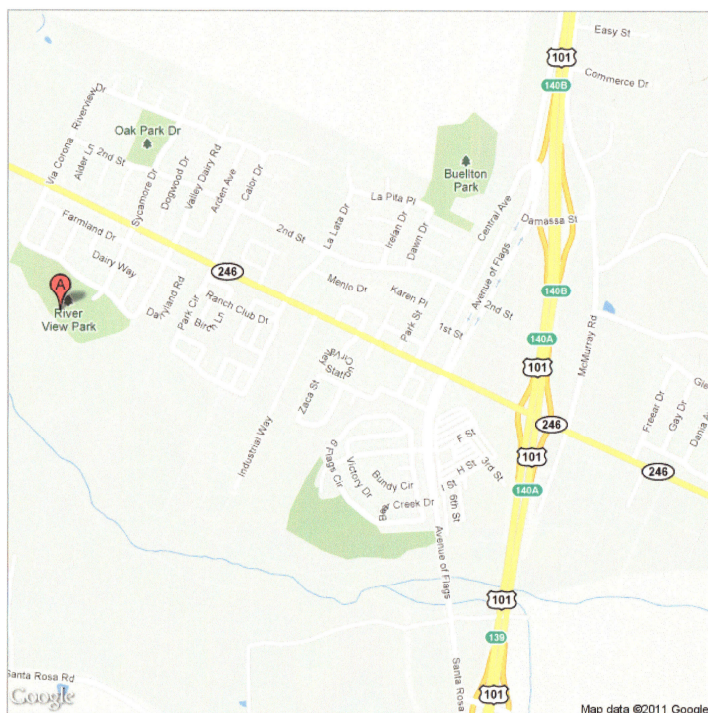

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED (on line forms and email url is considered Signature). Please check entry form before mailing to make sure it is legible and that all of the dog's titles are listed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- A separate entry blank must be completed for **each dog entered**. Please use care in clearly indicating which days and classes.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order in Test Classes. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- The MASCUSA Treasurer will mail any and all refund checks after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test or Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of

a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

- No entry fee will be refunded in the case of duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing of entries.
- A tub for cooling-off will be provided.
- Please bring your own chairs.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The MASCUSA will add a \$20.00 collection to the amount of each returned check.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the event site.
- **Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!**

EXHIBITORS INFORMATION

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.

Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. Unclaimed trophies become property of club.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Secretary is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. If a check is returned fees must be paid in guaranteed funds, checks will not be accepted as a replacement. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Secretary.

The Show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted, without signatures on forms sent by Mail. The "AGREEMENT" Section of the Official AKC Entry Form
